	Collapse of structures: Walls; beams; chimney breasts; roofs; other structures;		Support structures with props fitted by competent people?
	Exposure to building dusts: Prevent dust;		Use wet cutting; Vacuum extraction on tools; Vacuum instead of sweeping; Suitable well fitting mask;
	Exposure to asbestos: If asbestos is suspected DO NOT start work until a demolition/refurbishment asbestos survey has been carried out;		Inform all site workers etc of result of survey; Take remedial action as required;
	Workers or activities requiring supervision:		Who is delegated to supervise are they competent?
	Electricity:		Turn electricity and other supplies off before drilling into walls; Do not use excavators or power tools near buried services; Ensure low voltage power supply for tools;
	Risks to members of the public; clients; other visitors;		Ensure site security; Net scaffolding; Use rubbish chutes;
